Day 01: Arrive Delhi

Assistance upon arrival at Delhi airport followed by transfer to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 02: Delhi

After Breakfast you will proceed for a full day combined tour of Old & New Delh., Today you will visit Jama Masjid, Raj Ghat, Humayun Tomb, Qutab Minar, India Gate, Parliament House and Connaught place. In the evening enjoy the Light and Sound show. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 03: Delhi / Agra -distance 206 kms

Early morning visit The Monument of Love – Taj Mahal (TAJ MAHAL REMAINS CLOSED ON EVERY FRIDAY). After the visit, return back to the hotel for breakfast. After breakfast continue with the visits for the rest of the monuments in Agra. Visit Itmad-ul-daulah; Red Fort; Sikandra. After having visit, return back to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 04: Agra / Jaipur - distance 253 kms

After breakfast drive to Jaipur En route visit Fatehpur Sikri, "the Ghost City" which lies west of Agra. From here continue drive to Jaipur. Upon arrival check in to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 05: Jaipur

After breakfast drive to Amber Fort. Enjoy an elephant ride while going up the fort. In the afternoon, have a half day city tour of Jaipur. Places to visit include: City Palace; Jantar Mantar; Hawa Mahal (From outside only. After visit return back to the hotel. Overnight at the Hotel.

Day 06: Jaipur - Delhi - distance 281 kms

After breakfast drive to Delhi. Upon arrival you will provided departure transfer to the Delhi international airport to connect the flight for onwards journey.

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Program 02



Day 1: Arrive Delhi

Arrive at Delhi, meeting and assistance on arrival & transfer to the hotel.

Day 2: Delhi - Jaipur (By Surface 258 Kms)

After breakfast drive to Jaipur. On arrival check-in at hotel. Afternoon free for leisure activities. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 3: Jaipur

After breakfast enjoy an excursion to Amber Fort including an elephant ride. The Fort was originally built in the 16th century by Maharaja Man Singh. It encloses within it superb palaces and a beautiful temple in marble dedicated to the fearsome Goddess Kali. In the afternoon, visit the City Palace Museum which contains elaborate wardrobes, magnificent armory and intricate carved weapons. Close by is the Observatory built in 1728 by Jai Singh II. Also admire the Hawa Mahal (Wind Palace), from where the palace women could watch the activities of the big bazaar below, without being observed. A must-do in Jaipur is shopping? jewellery, handicrafts, clothes and the famous lakh bangles. Stay overnight at the hotel.

Day 4: Jaipur- Agra (By Surface 240 Km)

After breakfast leave for Agra - the City of the Taj. Visit Fatehpur Sikri en route- a World Heritage site, Akbar built to pay tribute to the great Sufi saint, Salim Chisti, for his blessings to the King. The Panch Mahal or the 'palace of five storeys' and the Buland Darwaza, a massive gate which provides entrance to the complex are among the finest specimens of Mughal architecture. Upon arrival, check into the hotel. In the evening, visit the Taj Mahal at sunset, the most extravagant monument ever built for love. The Agra Fort, built by Emperor Akbar is another attractive monument with the maze of courtyards, mosques and the private chambers of the Fort. Amongst other monuments are the Itmad-ud-Daulah or the Baby Taj, a smaller and quieter replica of the Taj. Stay overnight at the hotel.



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Day 5: Agra /Jhansi (Train)/ Khajuraho

Morning depart by train for Khajuraho. Depart Agra 0815 Hrs Bhopal Shtbdi Arrive Jhansi 1040 Hrs Meeting and assistance on arrival & drive to Khajuraho which is known the world over for its temples, sex, architecture and sculpture. The construction of these Temples are thousand-year old and took a little over two centuries. In terms of architecture of these temples, they form the high peak of the north Indian 'nagara' style. Out of the 85 temples believed to have been built between the 9th and 12th centuries only 20 have survived, many in splendid condition, others having given way to the ravages of time and nature. Afternoon free & overnight at the hotel.

Day 6: Khajuraho

Early morning excursion to Panna National Park by jeep, 32 km away and a mere 30 minutes' drive from Khajuraho which spreads along the river Ken. The Jungles today harbour many species of wildlife. The tigers can be glimpsed here, with other rare species such as the leopard, wolf and gharial. Herds of bluebull, chinkara and sambar are a common sight. In the afternoon return to Khajuraho & visit Eastern & Western group of temples. The world famous Khajuraho temples were built by the Chandela kings between 950 AD and 1050 AD. The most important are the Chaunset Yogini Temple dedicated to Goddess Kali, The Mahadev Temple, Chitragupta or Bharatji Temple with a lovely image of 11 headed Vishnu, Vishvanath and Nandi Temples, Lakshmana Temple, Visha Temple of Shiva, which is the largest & most typical of the temples. Visit the Eastern group of temples that consist of the Parasvanath Temple - the only Jain Temple surviving at Khajuraho and has excellent sculptures on the outer walls of the Sanctum, the Javeri Temple dedicated to Lord Vishnu. The other temples in this group are those dedicated to Brahma, Yamuna and Adinath. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 7: Khajuraho / Varanasi (Flight)

Morning at leisure afternoon transfer to airport to board the flight for Varanasi Depart Khajuraho 1330 Hrs 9W 724 Arrive Varanasi 1410 Hrs Meeting and assistance on arrival & transfer to hotel. Varanasi - The city that has ancient roots was also known as Kashi, as it was called in the olden times, is a supreme Hindu pilgrimage center as it is the permanent domain of Lord Shiva. In the evening, visit Sarnath, the place where Lord Buddha preached his first sermon after attaining enlightenment. It has a large stupa dating back to the 6th century as well as one of Ashoka's Pillar, the ruins of a brick temple and monasteries and a Museum. Stay overnight at the hotel.

Day 8: Varanasi

Early morning boat ride on the river Ganges. Immerse yourself in the absorbing spectacle of the devout pilgrims, residents and visitors from the world-over assembled on the banks of the Ganga to offer prayers. Morning city tour of Varanasi. In the afternoon visit Sarnath which lies 10 kilometres north east of Varanasi. It was here that Buddha preached his message of the 'middle way' to nirvana after achieving enlightenment at Bodhgaya. In around 234 BC, Emperor Ashoka, a great follower of Buddhism, erected a stupa here. Between the 3rd century BC and the 11th century AD, several Buddhist structures were built



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here in Sarnath. Most of the Sarnath's monuments are set in large gardens making it quite pleasant for a visitor to spend some time here.

Day 9: Varanasi - Delhi (Flight)

Morning free afternoon transfer to the airport for the flight to Delhi. Upon arrival, in Delhi connect flight for onward destination.

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Program 03



Day 01: Arrive Mumbai

Arrive at Mumbai, meeting assistance on arrival & transfer to your pre booked hotel. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 02: Mumbai - Aurangabad (Flight)

Morning after breakfast, enjoy half day tour of Mumbai City. Evening transfer to airport to board a flight to Aurangabad. On arrival meet the representative and escorted to your hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 03: Aurangabad - Mumbai (Flight)

Embark on a half day tour of the Ajanta Caves (around 100 km). Of the thirty monuments at Ajanta, four caves No 9, 10, 26 and 29 are sanctuaries or Chaitya containing a Stupa at the centre of their apses. The rest are monastic residences or Viharas. An Indian poet Kalidasa describes these caves as the gem set of jewellery, rich furniture, imposing architecture, natural scenery and fleeting expressions on the faces. Later tour of Ellora Caves (7th - 10th century AD). The magnificent group of rock temples of Ellora are a part of world heritage monuments. Ellora group of temples represents the art and sculptures of Buddhism, Hinduism and Jainism, the three dominant religions of India. Evening flight to Mumbai. Upon arrival transfer to the hotel. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 04: Mumbai- Udaipur (Flight)

Morning transfer to airport to board a flight to Udaipur. Upon arrival meet the representative and escorted to your hotel. Afternoon a half-day tour of Udaipur City (if time permits). Evening enjoy a boat ride on Lake Pichola. Overnight at hotel.

Day 05: Udaipur- Ranakpur -Jodhpur Distance: Approx 259 kms

Morning after breakfast drive to Jodhpur en route visits the 15th century Jain temples at Ranakpur. The main temple is dedicated to Adinath. It has 29 halls that take up most of the covered space and an army



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of over four hundred columns that raise the dome skywards. Intricate carvings detail mythological figures, patterns and motifs on the walls, pillars and domes. The scale is anything but compromising. Afternoon continue drive to Jodhpur, upon arrival, check into the hotel for an overnight at hotel.

Day 06: Jodhpur

After breakfast half day sightseeing of Jodhpur visit, Mehrangarh Fort, Jaswant Thada, Ummaid Bhawan Palace. Evening free for leisure. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 07: Jodhpur- Jaipur Distance: Approx 345 Kms

After breakfast drive to Jaipur. Upon arrival check in at hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 08: Jaipur

After breakfast 0800 Hrs enjoy an excursion to Amber Fort was originally built in the 16th century by Maharaja Man Singh. It encloses within it superb palaces and a beautiful temple in marble dedicated to the fearsome Goddess Kali. In the afternoon, visit the City Palace Museum, which contains elaborate wardrobes, magnificent armory and intricate carved weapons. Close by is the Observatory built in 1728 by Jai Singh II. Also admire the Hawa Mahal (Wind Palace), from where the palace women could watch the activities of the big bazaar below, without being observed. A must-do in Jaipur is shopping jewellery, handicrafts, clothes and the famous lakh bangles.

Day 09: Jaipur - Agra Distance: 232 Kms

Morning drive to Agra, enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri. On arrival check-in at hotel. Evening free. Overnight stay at hotel.

Day 10: Agra

Early morning visit The Monument of Love – Taj Mahal (TAJ MAHAL REMAINS CLOSED ON EVERY FRIDAY). After visit return back to the hotel for breakfast later visit: Itmad-ul-daulah, Red Fort, Sikandra. After visit return back to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 11: Agra-Jhansi (By Train) Jhansi-Orchha - Khajuraho Distance Jhansi - Khajuraho: 197 Kms

Morning board a train to Jhansi. On arrival meet the representative and drive to Khajuraho. Enroute visit Orchha. After visit continue drive to Khajuraho. Upon arrival, check in to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 12: Khajuraho

After breakfast visit the Eastern & western group of temples. After having visit return back to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 13: Khajuraho- Varanasi (Flight)

Morning at leisure. Afternoon transfer to airport to board a flight to Varanasi. Upon arrival meet assist and transfer to hotel. Evening arti tour on river Ganges. Overnight at the hotel.

Afternoon at 1300 Hrs visit the The Agra Fort, built by Emperor Akbar and is another attractive monument with the maze of courtyards, mosques and the private chambers of the Fort & you will also visit the Taj Mahal, the most extravagant monument ever built for love (You can stay there till sunset). Return to the hotel & overnight stay in the hotel.

Day 04: Agra - JaipurDistance - 232Kms

After breakfast drive to Jaipur. Enroute visit Fatehpur Sikri. After having visit drive to Jaipur. On arrival check in at the hotel. Overnight at hotel.

Day 05: Jaipur

Morning excursion to Amber Fort where you can enjoy the Elephant joy ride Afternoon City tour of Jaipur visiting Albert Hall museum,Hawa Mahal, Obervatory, City Palace, Museum etc. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 06: Jaipur - BikanerDistance - 340 Kms



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After breakfast you will drive to Bikaner, the city of deserts that has better come to be known for the mouth-watering? bhujias?, a traditional Indian dry, salty mixture, that it specializes in. Upon arrival check into the hotel. Take a tour of the city in the afternoon and visit the impressive Junagarh Fort. Visit the Chandra Mahal, or Moon Palace, with paintings, mirrors and carved marble panels and also the Phool Mahal. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 07: Bikaner - Jaisalmer Distance - 340 Kms

After breakfast drive to Jaisalmer- the "Golden City" of Rajasthan. Golden sands and rolling dunes are the popular images of Jaisalmer and a visit to this desert post will only confirm your impression. Upon arrival check into the hotel. The rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 08: Jaisalmer

After breakfast a half-day morning city tour of Jaisalmer where you will visit the Jaisalmer Fort. Once an important gate for trade route, Jaisalmer grew wealthy on the trade money. The Patwon-ki-Haveli is a group of five mansions that are probably the best in the area with their delicate carvings, pillars and murals. In the afternoon, proceed to Sam Sand Dunes on the outskirts of Jaisalmer and enjoy a camel ride to its famous Sunset Point. Return back to the hotel in the evening! Overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 09: Jaisalmer – Jodhpur Distance - 295 km

After breakfast drive to Jodhpur, the second largest city in Rajasthan. Upon arrival check into the hotel. In the afternoon, visit the Mandore Gardens, the capital of the Rathore clan before Jodhpur. Located within extensive gardens are the cenotaphs of the former Jodhpur rulers. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 10: Jodhpur- Udaipur Distance - 259 kms

Enjoy a half day city tour of Jodhpur. In the morning visit the Meherangarh Fort. Stop by at the Jaswant Thada which harbors royal cenotaphs built in white marble. Also visit the colorful local market around the popular landmark, the Clock Tower. In the afternoon drive to Udaipur, the Venice of the East, by road. En route visit the 15th century Jain temples at Ranakpur. Upon arrival, check into the hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 11: Udaipur

After breakfast you will have an excursion visit to the City Palace- a marvel of marble and granite. This is the largest palace in Rajasthan and never fails to delight one with its exquisite workmanship. Afternoon is free. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 12: Udaipur

After breakfast excursion to Eklingi & Nagda temple: About 23 kms from Udaipur through the splendid scenery and on the mountain pass is located the famous Eklingi Temple dedicated to Lord Shiva. Later visit Nagada named after its founder Nagaditya and one of the most ancient places in Mewar. Evening back to the hotel for overnight stay.



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Day 13: Udaipur - Delhi (Flight)

After breakfast you will leave for Delhi. Depart from the hotel to the airport from where you will take your flight. On arrival in Delhi connect flight for onwards journey.

The most ornated temple is perhaps the Mukteswar Temple built between 7-8 th century. Its architectural style is eclectic with the fusion of Hindu, Buddhist and Jain styles. The carved ceiling is an amazing piece of the marvelous temple architecture of Orissa. Perhaps the most magnificent temple in Bhubaneswar is the Lingaraja Temple built during the 10th or 11th century. In the afternoon you will visit the Orissa State Museum, Handicrafts Museum and the Tribal Museum. Evening back to the hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 04: Bhubaneswar



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In the morning there is a full day excursion to the Buddhist Caves of Lalitgiri, Udaigiri & Ratnagiri. The earliest Buddhist Complex dating back to the 1st century AD, Lalitgiri forms an important node of the Diamond Triangle ie Lalitgiri and Ratnagiri and Udayagiri. Well connected by excellent roads to Cuttack and Bhubaneswar, recent excavations here have brought to light significant archaeological material that upholds Lalitgiri as a great centre of Buddhist attraction. Day 05: Bhubaneswar

In the morning is a full day excursion to Chilka Lake. Queen of natural beauty, Chilika, the largest brackish water lake in Asia covering an area of over 1,100 sq. km is a great attraction for the tourists for fishing, bird watching and boating. In winter Chilika aflutter with thousands of indigenous and migratory birds of many varieties from far and near - even from the distant Siberia. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 06: Bhubaneswar - Puri Distance 60 Kms

In the morning drive to Puri en route visiting Dhauli, Pipli and Konark. Konark is one of the well-known tourist attractions of Orissa. Konark houses a colossal temple dedicated to the Sun God. Even in its ruined state it is a magnificent temple reflecting the genius of the architects that envisioned and built it. This temple built in 1278 CE by the Ganga King Narasimha Deva is one of the grandest temples of India and was referred to as the Black Pagoda. The ruins of this temple were excavated in late 19th century. Drive on and check into your hotel. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 07: In Puri

In the morning is a half-day tour of Puri Jagannath Temple, Gundicha Ghar, Temple of Child Krishna at Indradyumna Tank. Rest of the day is at leisure to relax on the beach. The only walkable beach on the eastern coast of India is the Puri white sand beach. Puri beach is characterised by its utter simplicity, the sweets and snacks hawkers, the wonderful and loving people, and the widespread white sand with the waters from Bay of Bengal continuously washing your feet while you walk. Day 08: Puri - Bhubaneswar - Kolkata (Flight)

After breakfast drop at Bhubaneswar airport to connect flight for Kolkata. Kolkata is the capital city of West Bengal state in India. The city is full of historical monuments and palaces and is therefore also called the "The City of Palaces". Later you will be provided departure transfer to the Kolkata international airport to connect the flight for onwards journey.

Simlipal National Park In time, transfer to the station to board the train to Balasore. Arrive at Balasore station and drive to Simlipal National Park. Later, take a nature walk and do the nature study in Herbal Nursery. Also take a tour of Crocodile Breeding Farm.

Day 3: Simlipal National Park

Have breakfast at the jungle lodge. Later, visit Barehipani and Joranda Waterfalls and enjoy the jeep safari to see the various wild animals.

Day 4: Simlipal National Park-Panchlingeshwar-Kuldiha

Post breakfast drive to Panchlingeshwar located at Nilagiri Hills. Arrive and check in to the jungle lodge. Later, visit Kuldiha Wildlife Sanctuary spread in 272 sq. KMS area. It has got the wide varieties of wild animals including tiger, Sambhar, gaur, reptiles and various birds.

Day 5: Bhadrak-Chandbali-Dangamal

Have breakfast and drive towards Chandbali through Bhadrak. Arrive at Chandbali and take the motorboat cruise for Dangamal Island. Arrive at Dangamal and check in to the forest guest house.

Day 6: Dangamal-Bhitarkanika Wildlife Sanctuary

After having breakfast at Dangamal proceed further to Bird Island. Here observe different varieties thousands of Indian and migratory birds. Take the cruise till Bhitarkanika Island. Arrive at Bhitarkanika and check in to the jungle lodge.

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Day 7: Bhitarkanika Wildlife Sanctuary-Ekkakula Island-Gahirmatha

Today, take again the motorboat towards Ekkakula Island located in the Bay of Bengal. It is an unknown and an un-spoilt island having a magnificent sunset view. Here track the wild boars, jackals and hyenas. Sometimes you may also spot dolphins in the sea. Later, visit the Olive Ridley Turtle Nesting Site located on the beach in Gahirmatha. After visit, drive to Bhubaneswar and check in to the hotel.

Day 8: Bhubaneswar-Nandankanan-Bhubaneswar

In the morning, leave Bhubaneswar for Nandankanan Zoo situated in Chandaka Forest along with Kanjia Lake. Nandankanan Zoo has very rich wildlife including white tiger, birds, Reptiles, Gharial, Crocodiles and Black Panthers. Here take the white tiger safari and visit Botanical Garden. Later, return back to Bhubaneswar to stay in the hotel.

Day 9: Bhubaneswar-Chilika Lake

After having early breakfast, transfer to Chilika Lake spread in an area of 1100 sq. KMS. It is the biggest salty water lake of Asia and has thousands of different birds. Arrive at Chilika and check in to the resort at Barkul. Later, cruise over Chilika Lake through motor launch spotting various bird species.

Day 10: Chilika Lake-Bhubaneswar-Departure

Have leisurely breakfast and take a tour of Nirmala Jhar temple, Banpur and Narayani temple. Later, transfer to Bhubaneswar airport to catch the flight to onward destination.
